

Respondus LockDown Browser and **Respondus Monitor** will be used to proctor you during the Math Placement Exam. It is important for you to familiarize yourself with the set-up procedure in advance of the assessment so that you don't have to worry about such things once it is time for you to take the exam.

To begin, please watch the (really short) video below about **Respondus LockDown Browser**.

Now, to install ... click on the link below and then click on "Install Now". Follow the instructions to install the downloaded software. Please be sure to download the correct file (windows or Mac); otherwise it won't work.

Once Installed

- Start LockDown Browser
- Log into to Canvas
- Navigate to the assessment

Note: You won't be able to access an assessment that requires LockDown Browser with a standard web browser. If this is tried, an error message will indicate that the test requires the use of LockDown Browser. Simply start LockDown Browser and navigate back to the exam to continue.

To ensure the MPE runs smoothly, we'd like you to take a practice quiz that requires Respondus Lockdown Browser and Monitor. It's located in the NMSU-MPE course in Canvas under Quizzes.
